Knights Stand Strong: The Numbers Behind the Need

Nordonia's schools are at a crossroads. Without this levy, critical programs, small class sizes and safe, well-maintained schools are at risk. Here's what's at stake and why **we must act now.**

➡ No New Money Since 2019

It's been five years since Nordonia passed an operating levy.

- 2019: Voters approved a 6.3-mill levy
- **2025:** The district is asking for 5 mills
- 2 mills from an old bond expired this year, making the 5-mill request feel like 3 mills

What Will the Average Homeowner Pay?

- \$8.75/month per \$100K appraised value
- \$26.25/month for a \$300K home

What's at Risk if the Levy Fails?

- School building closure/consolidation
- Busing reductions/eliminations
- Afterschool and community athletic programs lose facility access
- AP, STEM, arts and student support courses cut

Nordonia Has Taken Action to Reduce Costs

- 10.5 teaching positions reduced through attrition
- 39.5 teaching and support positions eliminated in February 2025
- 3 full-time support staff eliminated in 2024
- 3 K-12 counseling positions cut, removing crucial student support services
- Experienced teacher buyout (estimated loss of 300 years of expertise)
- Athletic and arts fees increased, saving \$27,000

Fiscal Responsibility Recognized

- The Nordonia School District has received the Ohio Auditor of State Award with Distinction 10 of the last 11 years
- Only 5% of school districts and public institutions earn this honor
